Traditional professions



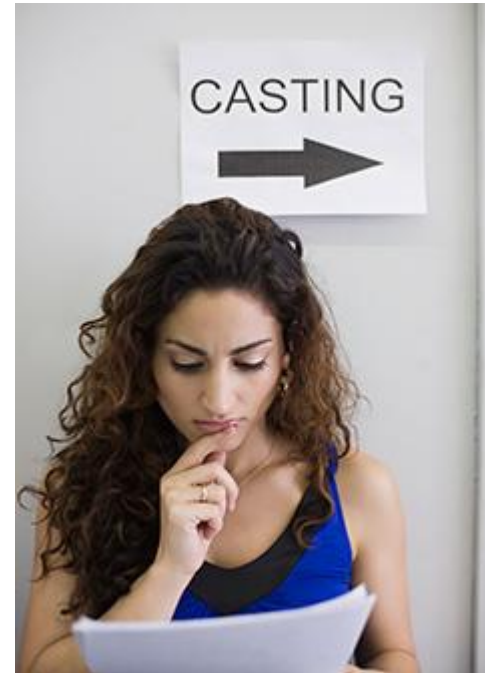
- Baker, shoe maker, doctor, nurse, butcher, blacksmith, bricklayer, tailor,
